Who should attend?

Content:

The one day course provides informative practical training on the law and procedure that underpins the leasehold conveyancing process. It examines what are the key components of a well drafted residential lease, the different aspects of the conveyancing process and focuses on issues including, prescribed clauses, the demise structure and common parts, repairing obligations, insurance, forfeiture, alienation and service charge as well as landlord and leaseholder covenants.

Particular attention is given to onerous lease provisions – ground rent, administration charges, legal costs and term as well as exploring lender requirements and basic issues such as the difference between leasehold and freehold acquisitions and the disadvantages of the former over the latter.

The course examines the process from taking instructions to completion and file closure and explores forms to be completed and dealing with clients.

Delegates are provided with a training manual and are given ample opportunity to ask questions of the course presenter.

Who Provides the Training?

The course is delivered by **Ian Quayle** who was in practice for many years but who now devotes the majority of his time training conveyancers nationally either through his own training company or for a majority of the major training providers. Over 15 years Ian has delivered over 1500 training courses to a number of law firms, local law societies, professional bodies and institutions.
