In memory of Dudley Dean

It is with sadness that I share the news of the passing of Dudley Dean, one of the founding partners of Dean Wilson, at the age of 93.

Dudley was a central figure in the formation of Weekes, Legg and Dean in 1972, whose offices were located at 4 & 5 Pavilion Buildings in Brighton. This partnership laid the foundation for what would eventually become Dean Wilson LLP. One of Dudley's most notable contributions was his work on the Brighton Marina public enquiry—at the time, the largest case and fee in the firm's history.

He was known not only for his legal acumen but also for his forward-thinking approach to technology, championing innovations such as teleprinters and later email, and open-plan working.

Perhaps most importantly, Dudley was deeply supportive of young lawyers, offering guidance, encouragement, and mentorship to many who would go on to become partners of Dean Wilson. I'm sure you will join me in reflecting on his long life and the enduring impact he had on his firm and our local legal community.

COUNCIL MEMBERS REPORT

The Law Society's Q2 Council meeting took place on 1 July 2025, with a follow-up session on 15 July to conclude business related to the Solicitors Regulation Authority (SRA). As is customary, the Council faced a demanding agenda, supported by an extensive 321-page pre-reading pack, reflecting the breadth and complexity of matters under discussion. This article summarises the key items addressed, including the President's Report—highlighting priorities around justice, professional pride, and the Society's bicentenary—as well as Council's scrutiny of organisational performance and a significant development in the Society's oversight of the SRA. In particular, for the first time, the Council formally resolved that it is not sufficiently assured of the SRA's regulatory performance under section 28 of the Legal Services Act 2007, following serious concerns over its handling of the Axiom Ince case.
